#### <u>Summary</u>:

The 2019 updates to the Town's Comprehensive Land Use Plan (LUP) were done in-house. Although staff, Planning Board, and Board of Aldermen put a lot of thought & effort into the update process, we are finding a number of substantial deficiencies with the plan.

The latest Board discussion on strategic growth (especially residential zoning districts) led to a follow-up discussion between our Planner, Mayor, and Mayor Pro-Tem about how best to address the Board's concerns. In short: the planner explained that:

- 1. First, the concerns need to be incorporated within the LUP (the vision where the Town wishes to be); and then
- 2. Then staff, the PB, & BOA study/amend zoning districts and ordinances "consistent" with the LUP vision (to accomplish how to get there).

The manager was planning to present discussion about having the LUP professionally reviewed in the upcoming FY23 budget. After this discussion however, Mayor Barnhardt asked to add the item onto this agenda for discussion with the recommended action below (Rick Flowe, N Focus' owner / CEO advised he could not be present for the Board's 4/11/22 meeting, but could be available to meet 4/18/22).

The 2022 NCLM Nominating Committee has released its 2022-2023 Slate of Candidates on April 12th. The slate of candidates presented by the nominating committee shall be elected by electronic voting and the results shall be announced on April 28, 2022 during the NCLM Annual Business meeting at the CityVision Annual Conference.

Each member municipality is eligible to cast a single vote for candidates to the NCLM Board of Directors presented by the nominating committee. You have been designed as your municipality's Voting Delegate, and your single vote serves the interest for your municipality.

Newly elected officers shall hold their offices for a term of one year or until the succeeding annual meeting and until their successors are elected and shall qualify. Newly elected directors shall hold their offices for a term of two years or until the second succeeding annual meeting after their respective terms begin and until their successors are elected and shall qualify.

# IMPORTANT INFORMATION TO KNOW PRIOR TO SUBMITTING YOUR VOTE - PLEASE READ

- You are the designated voting delegate casting a single vote for your member municipality.
- There is ONE QUESTION on the ballot. You will vote either YES or NO on the full slate of candidates.

- The ballot form will allow for only ONE VOTE PER MUNICIPALITY.
- All information must be completed in order for the ballot to be received and accepted.
- Once a vote has been cast for your municipality, you will be unable to resubmit or change your vote.
- The election results will be presented in Wilmington, on April 28, 2022 during the NCLM Annual Business meeting at the CityVision Conference.
- Voting deadline is April 20, 2022.
