Aubrey received the following information Ms. Terrelle Banner, the Nutrition Manager for Rufty Holmes Senior Center.

Currently, the number of individuals attending the East Rowan site is 25-30.

We will need the use of a fridge to store cold items that we will serve for that day and the milk as well. We may use the stove to keep some food items warm. We serve the meal at noon and afterwards staff will start breaking down the facility such as; putting away supplies and cleaning. We do have a mobile three compartment steam well that we use to hold the temperature of the food, a coffee pot, tea dispenser and other small items so we do require some storage. Normally facilities just grant us use of a storage cabinet.

Yes, we will need the use of the facility Monday –Friday from 9:30am-1:30pm. We will need a parking lot and a safe entrance for the individuals to utilize as well as handicap accessible restrooms and at least one handicap accessible entrance. I will have to secure a sanitation permit and an operating permit so if you have a facility in mind I would need to look at it.

As far as requiring services from the Town Maintenance; only if it is property of the Town and an issue should arise.
